300. Champagne Baron-Fuente NV €75
60%Meunier, 30% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Noir, Ideal as a casual aperitifs as well as cooked, and grilled seafood dishes

301. Champagne Bollinger Special Cuvée €120
Special Cuvée is composed of over 85% Grand and Premier crus of the three main Champagne varieties: 60% Pinot Noir, 25%Chardonnay and 15% Meunier. It is cellar aged for twice as long as required by appellation regulations. It is moderately dosed at between 7 and 8 grams per litre.

302. Bollinger Brut Rosé N.V €156
Bollinger is regarded as one of the finest houses in Champagne. Remarkable Champagne

303 . Bolney Estate "Bolney Bubbly" N.v €80
Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir. Three years on the lees before disgorgement with 11 grams per litre. Multiple award winning English sparkling wine.

Limoux - France

304. Salasar Cremant de Limoux €40
Crisp & dry, flavours of pear, lemon and brioche. Perfectly balanced with refreshing acidity. Excellent Value.

PIEMONTE - Italy

298. Prosecco Frizzante NV €30
Soft honeyed apple fruits and long rich finish.

WACHAU

305. Domäne Wachau Riesling Federspiel Terrassen | 2018 €48

Distinctively more crisp and steely than some German Riesling. Super vintage, extremely aromatic with a long lingering finish. Multiple awards, scoring 90+ with each vintage.

Weinviertel

307. Gemischter Satz | 2014 €42

50 year old vines, a blend of 17 different grape varieties combine beautifully to create spicy and wonderfully complex wine.

GERMAN WHITE

311. Willi Haag Brauneberger Juffer Riesling-Auslese | 2001 €88

Superb Riesling, honeyed citrus, lime peel, rose petals and orange blossom.

Rheingau

312. Bender Paulessen | 2018 €35

Light honey colour, aromas of ripe apricot and apple, with a slight mineral finish.

313. Hochheimer Domdechaney Riesling Trocken Goldkapse I 2014 €65

This father and daughter operation represents the 7th and 8th generation to cultivate the vines and the results are remarkable; these are iconic wines from some of Germany's finest slopes. At the Spätlese level this dry Riesling is opulent, with hints of peach and apricot. Long aromatic finish. 92+/100 from Robert Parker and Wine Spectator.

314. Leitz Rüdesheimer Kabinett | 2010 €48

100% Riesling from an outstanding producer. On the palate, the wine is juicy and refreshing. Works beautifully with some grilled teriyaki salmon or Roquefort

330. Zagalia Pinot Grigio | 2022

€32 | €8 Glass

Light with fresh green citrus character. Very easy drink as an aperitif or with salad. Excellent value.

Alsace

333. Hugel Reisling | 2016

€35

Exotic summer fruits, wonderful balance of acidity and ripe fruit. Superb producer.

Chablis

336. Chablis Collet A.C | 2023

€55

Green and red apple with oyster-shell aromas. The palate is bursting of lime, apple and minerals.

337. Domaine Gerard Collet Chablis 1er Cru | 2022

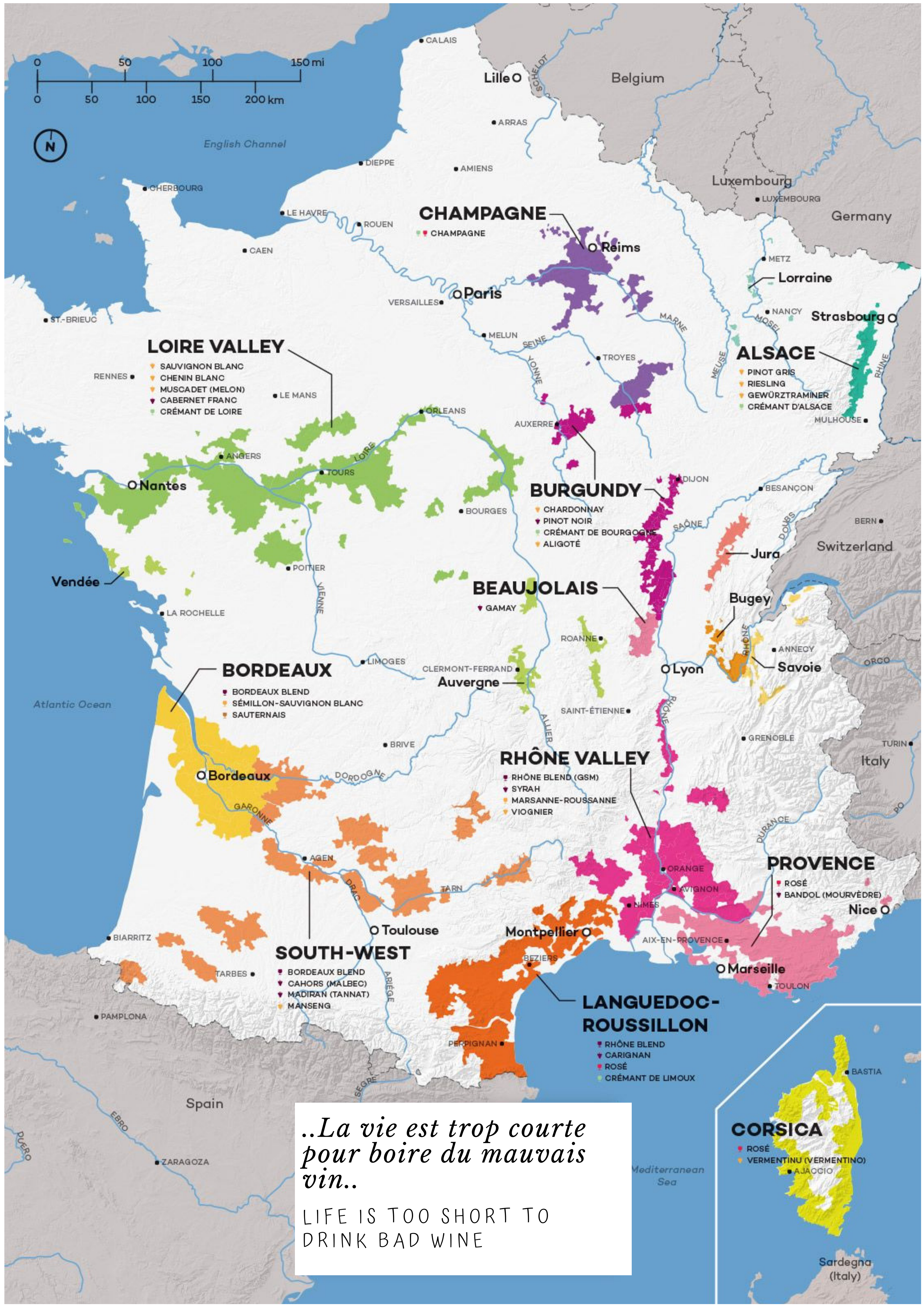

Beautiful mineral and citrus fruit which is quite tight initially but opens up to reveal a burst of complex fruits.

338. Chablis Grand CRU "Vaudesir" | 2008

€135

Domaine Gerard Tremblay. Aged beautifully. The full structure of the wines will take several years to develop.



Côte de Beaune

339. Henri et Gilles Buisson 'SAINT-ROMAIN AC 'Sous la Velle' | 2011 €75

Eighth generation of Buisson vignerons, The domaine is a Fine source of terroir-expressive wines offering outstanding value. Incredible mouthfeel and amplitude while remaining light.

340. Louis Latour Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru | 2009 €376 (Limited)

Seventh generation Louis Fabrice Latour is regarded as one of the traditionalists of Burgundy, and this amazing vintages epitomises everything the family aim to achieve. This 2009 vintage is prized all over the world, scoring 97/100, gold medal awards and delivers some of the finest expression available from this super location.

Côte Mâconnais

350. Domaine Emilian Gillet Viré Clessé 2016 | €55

Incredibly rich and full bodied, buttery with a refreshing acidity which is really outstanding value. Critics have scored this amazing wine consistently 90+/100.

Meursault

351. Maison Louis Latour Meursault | 2017 €140

Meursault is the most extensive southerly white wine commune of the Côte-d'Or. The perfect south-easterly exposure and the stony, marl soil contribute greatly to the remarkable finesse of which the wines of Meursault are capable. (2017 James Suckling -February 2019 -92/100).

Sancerre

352. Domaine Serge Laloue Sancerre Cuvee Silex | 2020 €66

Vines have an average age of 40 years, producing low yields of concentrated fruit. The vines face a south-easterly orientation, maximising exposure to the sun to assist ripening of the berries. The soils are 'silex', a flinty clay which produces elegant wines which are very distinctive. Fully Organic and Vegan, Outstanding example.

WHITE WINE

Gascony

355. Le Grand Noir Rose | 2022

€32 €8 Glass

Pale pink. Intense aromas of raspberry, strawberry and redcurrant with a hint of pepper. Rich palette with refreshing bright red fruit, brambley and peppery character. Combines dry flavors – it has almost no residual sugar – with lovely fruit-sweetness

356. La Grand Noir Chardonnay | 2022

€32 | €8 Glass

This is a fresh wine, with the apple, melon and pineapple flavors of the Chardonnay, a touch of mango and ginger from the Viognier and a subtle hint of oak.

Provence

357. Château D'Esclans "Whispering Angel" Rose | 2020

€50

Sacha Lichine's vision was to create the one of the greatest rosés in the world, igniting the "Rosé Renaissance". Now in its sixteenth vintage, very much a cult classic.

Rias Baixas

358. Pionero Albarino | 2020

€42

100% Albarino, Clean and crisp with tropical notes of pineapple, passion fruit. Perfectly balanced.

Getaria

359. Ameztoi Txakoli di Getaria | 2018

€39

Hand-harvested, fermented in stainless steel tanks and bottled with residual Co2 which gives the wine its typical light fizz. sea-infused, mineral citrus notes, perfect with some shellfish. 91/100 Stephen Tanzer

Monterri DO

361. Tempestad Godelloego 2017 |

€40

Fresh mineral nose with hints of green fruits (apple) is followed by a very rich palate

362. Willowglen Gewürztraminer Riesling | 2020

€32 | €8 Glass

Third generation family wine company established by Vittorio and Giuseppina De Bortoli in 1928. Selected parcels of Gewurztraminer and Riesling were chosen for their varietal characteristics to enhance the flavour profile for this wine. Super wine with Poultry or Teriyaki salmon.

New Zealand White

Marlborough

363. Emperor Point Sauvignon Blanc | 2022

€32 | €8 Glass

100% Sauvignon, crisp and full of flavour. Fresh, crisp and with lively fruit flavours of gooseberry, pineapple and green apple .

364. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc | 2020

€55

"Despite vintage variation, there's no denying the consistency of this iconic wine after almost 37 years. Compared to the structured and high-acid 2020, this is a vintage to enjoy now, with a weighty, fleshy palate of gooseberry, freshly cut grass and sweet grapefruit." Decanter (93 Points Wine Spectator, May 2022).

Napa Valley

365. Grgich Hills Estate Chardonnay | 2020

€75

Iconic wine, regarded as one of the best chardonnay's in the world. Consistently scoring 92+, a non-malolactic wine, hint of Hazelnut, bright pineapple, medium bodied with a long clean finish.

Piemont

373. Paolo Conterno Riva Del Bric 2020

€62

Classis and distinguished Barolo from Paolo Conterno, 100% Nebbiolo, typical garnet red. Bouquet packed with floral and fruity aromas. Elegant, robust body, nicely soft on the finish; showing hints of cherries and wild berries. 93/100 "A fresh, expressive version, featuring ripe cherry, plum, licorice and spice".

374. Prunotto Barolo | 2014

€160

Prunotto began its journey back in 1905, but has become one of the leading innovators for the region. The malolactic fermentation terminated before the end of the winter. The wine was aged in 27, 55 and 77 hectoliter oak casks. A further twelve month period of bottle aging in the Prunotto cellars. This is an outstanding example of what Barolo should be.

375. Voerzio Gianni Barolo La Serra | 1997

100% Nebbiolo from an outstanding producer, consistently scoring in the 90's for blind tasting. Super wine with steak or veal with rich tannins. Very light terracotta colour, ageing beautifully and just reintroduced to our list for 2015.

Veneto

376. Amarone Della Valpolicella Tenute Falezza | 2018

€90

Aromas of freshly grated coconut, nutmeg and sweet spices. Morello cherry fruit on the nose. Dry, then, on the palate, full-bodied.

377. Stefano Accordini Amarone Della Valpolicella DOCG 2020

€95

Highly Distinguished label, multi-award winning, Full-bodied with great structure.

378. Fattori col de la Bastia Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore

2020

€45

450 metres above sea level 12 hectares located in Bastia, exactly on the valley between the Val d'Alpone and Val d'Illasi. Highly regarded, always scoring 90+/100. Great Value Powerhouse.

Abruzzo

380. Amaranta Montepulciano D'Abruzzo | 2018

€50

Great structure, complex, elegant, well balanced with a long aftertaste. Opulent fruit. Ideal for roasts, game, strongly flavoured dishes and mature cheese.

381. Ulisse Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOP | 2022

€32

This wine has a ruby red colour with garnet reflections. Intense, persistent and fruity and flowery fragrance with hints of cherry, blackberries, ripe red fruits. Well-bodied, tannic and well balanced. Excellent with flavoured first dishes, roast meats, mature cheeses and dark chocolate.

Chianti

388. Chianti Classico Cavalleresco DOCG | 2020

€35

Sangiovese grapes, with the addition of small quantities of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, give this robust wine its intense ruby red colour. A brief period of aging in oak casks and bottles favours the development of a fine bouquet that verges on the scent of violets, with hints of wood and a warm, well-rounded flavour accompanying an excellent body.

Sicily

390. Tenuta di Castellaro Nero Ossidiana | 2015

€63

Made by blending 60% Corinto, 20% Nero d'Avola and 20% other varieties, this opens with aromas of underbrush, game, leather, spice and mature black fruit. The warm palate delivers smooth tannins and flavors of blackberry, prune and black pepper. Very distinctive style bursting with complexities. Vintages constantly scoring 90+/100.

SPANISH RED

Jumilla

400. Sabatacha Monastrell | 2018

€45

100% Monastrell, Red and black fruit with mineral hints. Manual harvesting and 4 months in oak barrels. Multiple award winner including - Gold Medal Berliner Wine Trophy 2014.

Ribera del Duero

401. 12 Linajes Reserva DOCE | 2018

€55

Predominately red and black fruits, ripe tannins with a hint of balsamic. Fantastic wine which is layered with technical contrasts, a real gem, multiple award winner consistently achieving critics scores of 92+/100 and Gold medals.

Rioja

402. Conde Valdemar Rioja Crianza | 2011

€32 | €8 Glass

90% Tempranillo and 10% Mazuelo, perfect to accompany game dishes, roasts and grilled red meat. Conde Valdemar is consistently scoring multiple awards for each vintage and is regarded one of Spain's greatest producers for outstanding Rioja.

403. Muga Reserva | 2020

€50

This 2020 vintage has a bright ruby-red colour, with medium depth and a garnet-tinged rim. This wine will be an excellent accompaniment to meat dishes. Aged in 80% French oak and 20% American. Before bottling the wine is fined using fresh egg whites. It then spends a minimum of 12 months in our bottle cellar to give it greater complexity and finesse.

404. Prado Enea Muga | 2005

€280

Aged in vat for 1 year, 4 years in barrel and 3 years in bottle. Released unfiltered to the market. 80% Tempranillo the rest being Garnacha, Mazuelo, Graciano. The aromas are stunning, offering concentrated scents of spices, cedar, fruitcake, ripe black fruits intermixed with toasty aromas. 90+ point award winner.

Navarra

405. Ochoa Tempranillo Reserva | 2015

€50

Aged for 12 months in 225L American oak casks, after which it is finished in the bottle, perfect with a grilled steak, Lamb or a cheese platter.

406. Ochoa Gran Reserva | 2014

€80

24 Months aged in French and American Oak, family owned and operated with roots dating back to 1370 AD. Fantastic wine and excellent value.

Penedes

408. Torres Mas La Plana | 2010

€90

100% Cabernet Sauvignon with a deep cherry colour, Full bodied & perfect with meat and game. Consistent 92 +/100 every year. Fantastic value.

FRENCH RED

Cote de Nuits

409. Louis Latour Gevrey - Chambertin | 2017

€95

This is a classic Pinot, it exhibits aromas of red cherry, raspberry and cranberry. Medium bodied with smooth tannins, subtle oak and a slight mineral finish.

Vosne - Romanee

410. Bruno Clair 'Champs Perdrix' | 2008

€130

Striking expression of Pinot Noir from Morey-Saint-Denis appellation; This 2008 shows exceptional balance, with a depth of flavour that reflects its age and terroir. Drinking perfectly now but will cellar for years. Perfect with Roast duck.

Pommard

412. Domaine Lejeune 1er Cru Les Argilieres | 2011

€90

Lejeune are known for their traditional approach, manual harvests, minimal intervention. Drinking perfectly now. The nose is typical of Lejeune wines, sweetly perfumed with plenty of red berry flavours, the palate is dense and balanced with ripe raspberry

Santenay

414. Domaine Bachey- Legros 1er Cru Clos Rousseau Les Fourneaux | 2022 €89

Family-run estate known for its tradition and emphasis of expressing the unique terroirs. The "Fourneaux" parcel within the Clos Rousseau Premier Cru vineyard is distinguished by its ancient vines, resulting in low yields and resulting in smooth tannins and rich flavours. Excellent.

Nuits St Georges

414. David Duband, Nuits St Georges | 2017 €125

2011 was a cooler year that required skilled winemaking due to the variable weather, Duband managed it perfectly. This 2011 stands out for its vibrancy and freshness. Perfect balance of fruit and savory elements, marked by a leaner, more refined profile that Burgundy lovers appreciate.

RED WINE

Côte-Rôtie

420. Yves Cuilleron Bassenon | 2007

€225

Stephen Tanzer awarded this wine 92/100, Wine Spectator 91/100. Cuilleron took over the family domaine in 1987, and has since grown it significantly, establishing himself as one of the leading producers of France's Northern Rhone region. 90% Syrah & 10% Viognier grown on 1.5 ha of south-facing terraced vines on Coteau de Semons, in Tupin-Semons commune. Delicate floral nose, beautifully balanced with silky tannins.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape

421. Victor Berard | 2022

€80

75% Grenache, 12% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre, 3% Cinsault. Full-bodied, dense, concentrated and layered which is definitely one of the top efforts in the vintage. Perfect with fillet of Irish beef or mature cheese.

Côtes du Rhône

422. Laudun Côtes du Rhône Villages A.C | 2020

€40

80% Tannat & 20% Cabernet Sauvignon aged in 50% new barrels for 14 months. This is a very big wine, full on flavours, meaty, with huge a structure and layers of dark plum, pepper and spice flavours. Full-bodied, with baker's chocolate, almost black in colour. Layers upon layers of chewy fruit of the forest. Astonishing example.

Gigondas

423. Domaine Chapoutier Gigondas | 2020

€60

From eight different vineyards (lieux-dits) where the soils are composed of red and blue clays, limestone and sand. The blend is Grenache (75%) with 10% Syrah, 13% Mourvèdre, 2% Cinsault from vines aged between 35 and 50 years old. Natural yeast and 30% whole cluster fermentation.

Madiran

424. Château Montus Prestige | 1997

€265

80% Tannat & 20% Cabernet Sauvignon aged in 50% new barrels for 14 months. This is a very big wine, full on flavours, meaty, with huge a structure and layers of dark plum, pepper and spice flavours. Full-bodied, with baker's chocolate, almost black in colour. Layers upon layers of chewy fruit of the forest. Astonishing example.

Cahors

425. Château Du Cédre 'La Cedre' | 1998

€180

100% Malbec, aged for 24 months in oak barrels (80% new, half of them 500l). Family estate run by Pascal and Jean-Marc Verhaeghe, 20 to 55 year old vines, with a planting density of 4000 to 5500 vines per hectare Yields are limited to 30 hectolitres per hectare and a vineyard team of 12 people. This is an outstanding Malbec with scores as high as 95/100, it would be difficult to Find a better Malbec anywhere in the world.

Touraine

426. Domaine Couly-Dutheil 'Clos de L'Echo Chinon' | 2008

€205

100% Cabernet Franc from a super producer, vines up to 95 years old and manual harvesting with an average yield of 40hl/ha. Intensely flavoured and complex bouquet with ripe grapes & spicy notes. Concentrated and elegant tannins. 91/100 Wine Spectator.

Côtes Du Roussillon Tautavel

427. Château Seguala | 2020

€40

Tuatavel is one of only four Cru Villages located in Cotes de Roussillon, the granite soils around Tautavel force the vines deep in search of minerals, creating a unique Terrior in which to cultivate the grape. Blend of Syrah, Grenache, Carignan and Mourvedre this is a cracking good example.

Bandol

428. Domaine Tempier | 1997

€150

1997 is an Outstanding example; Lucien Peyraud has done a great deal to resurrect the reputation of the wines of Bandol. Peyraud was instrumental in setting the high minimum requirement of 50% Mourvedre and for keeping the yield of juice per acre restricted. No fining or filtering.

Bordeaux - Haut-Médoc

430. Château Belle-Vue | 2018

€69

Cabernet Sauvignon 50%, Merlot Noir 30% and Petit Verdot 20%, acquired by Vincent Mulliez 2004 the Chateau has pushed for excellence. Multiple award winning example, consistently scoring 90+/100. Rich, generous character that gives it a full, dense texture. Spice, ripe tannins and opulent blackberry tones.

RED WINE

Bordeaux - Pauillac

432. Château Grand-Puy Ducasse Cru Classé | 2003

€190

After hand-picking and selection of the grapes on the vines, they are de-stalked and carefully sorted once more. Fermentation in temperature controlled stainless-steel tanks. After blending, the wine is aged from 18 to 24 months in French oak barrels. 60% Cabernet Sauvignon & 40% Merlot, a very elegant wine with soft and shining tannins, supporting the expression of the fruits. The structure is lovely combining suppleness and style. 90/100 Robert Parker.

433. Château Lynch Moussas | 2000

€180

Robert Parker Jnr. "Probably the best effort I have tasted from Lynch-Moussas in my career! Deep ruby/purple, with a sweet nose of creme de cassis intermixed with liquorice, dried herbs, and vanilla, the wine is rich in fruit, has good glycerine, silky tannin, and a nice, spicy, layered finish.

434. Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande Grand Cru Classé | 1989 €1820 (Limited)

This wine is regarded as being in the top 1% of all wine ever produced. Pauillac is said to be quintessential Bordeaux and I could not write enough about this wine to do it the justice it deserves.

435. Château Lynch Bages | 2003

€1040

Unquestionably Lynch-Bages, and a great one at that. The palate is spicy and rich with a touch of raisin. Firm and elegant on the Finish but lacks some grip. The nose has definitely improved after barrel maturation. Good vigour with blackberry, tar and orange zest. Most recently awarded 98/100 Wine spectator, Superb.

436. Château Grand Puy Lacosta | 1992

€280

This was a very difficult vintage for Bordeaux. The top properties implemented a ruthless selection and crop thinning to reduce the crop size. Parkers wine guide proclaimed this wine a star of the vintage. Offering ripe fruit up-front cassis flavours ideal for drinking over the next 5/7 years.

Bordeaux - Fronsac

437. Château De La Dauphine Fronsac | 2000

€210

Jean Halley acquired Château de la Dapuhine from the Moueix family in 2000, investing over ten million in the property. 90% merlot & 10% cabernet franc with average vines of 33 years. Very rare to find this impeccable 2000 vintage.

Bordeaux - Margaux

438. Château Rauzan Segla | 2003

€290

Deep ruby, very good concentration, leafy high-Cabernet nose, great intensity of fruit and fragrance and very long on the palate. Shows tremendous class and will be very, very elegant. 2009-25.

450. Château Siran | 2018**€95**

Very deep ruby, concentrated, perhaps over-concentrated nose, lots of blackcurrant fruit and very good tannic/acid balance, rather less smooth than many at the moment, but has true depth of Cabernet fruit and potential complexity.

Saint-Estephe**452. Château Cos D Estournel | 1988****€1280 (Limited)**

This quality wine is one of the best examples from St Estephe. It is the most prestigious property in St- Estephe. The wine is big and powerful very robust. Huge concentrated flavour with massive depth and very long finish. A high level of Merlot (40%) complements the Cabernet Sauvignon (60%). 90+/100.

Pomerol**453. Château Bellegrave | 2021****€135**

Decanter magazine "Blackberry, cherry, vanilla and earthy fruit aroma. Firm fruit with good perfume, a lovely minerality and iron notes from the Pomerol soil. Fresh, sleek, integrated oak and a lovely zip in the middle". Represents great value for Pomerol and the tannins have begun to subdue slightly.

454. Château Beauregard | 2019**€164**

With origins dating back to the 12th century and to the Knights Hospitaller, to whom we owe the famous Templar Cross logo. Consisting of Merlot and 30% Cabernet Franc. Château Beauregard watches over a 17.5 hectare vineyard certified for Organic Agriculture. Aged 30 years on average, the vines are planted in a clayey-gravelly soil on the south-eastern edge of the famous Pomerol plateau.

455. Ballade de La Pointe | 2019**€85**

In 2008 Eric Monneret and his team embarked upon several projects aiming to optimise the quality of the wines, Ballade has been thriving since. The 2019 is beautifully balanced with impressive depth and complexity.

456. Château Fayat | 2016**€120**

Well defined with black cherries and blackcurrent, medium bodied. 87% Merlot, 13% Cabernet franc, hand harvested, aged 12 months in 50% new oak. wine Spectator 91/100. 14-16 months in French Oak. Neighboring Château Petrus, this is an excellent Pomerol.

457. Château La Patache | 2021**€95**

The 2020 La Patache offers a deep ruby hue, a vibrant nose and a full bodied well-structured wine showcasing rich flavours of dark berries, cassis and dark chocolate. Beautifully balanced Pomerol with great ageing potential over the next decade.

458. Château Franc-Maillet | 2018**€95**

This 2018 is drinking beautifully now, a superb expression of Pomerol's terroir. The tannins are supple and structured providing a fine long-lasting finish. Palate is concentrated, revealing layers of dark fruit, licorice and dark chocolate.

459. Château L'Enclos 2020**€130**

The 2019 L'Enclos is a standout example of Pomerol, showcasing the elegance and power of Merlot-based wines from this prestigious appellation. Perfectly capturing the essence of the terroir and vintage, enjoyable now but will continue to develop and soften over the next decade or more.

460. Château Montviel | 2020**€95**

"Another brilliant Pomerol in the vintage, the 2020 Château Montviel has a pure, medium to full-bodied, vibrant profile carrying darker, almost blue, iron-tinged fruits, lots of violet, floral, and chocolate nuances, fine tannins, and outstanding length". 94/100 Jeb Dunnuck.

RED WINE

Bordeaux - St. Julien

461. Château Gruaud Larose | 2000

€420

Cabernet Sauvignon 60% and Merlot 30% with Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot 10%. Guard Larose requires patience to fully open and with that in mind we have only released this 2000 vintage for the first time in 2015. One of the greatest value wines available anywhere on our list with too many accolades to mention. This vintage is simply Superb.

Languedoc

462. Preignes Le Vieux Cabernet Sauvignon | 2023

€32 €8 Glass

Dark ruby, deep and intense. Tannins are present and blended in. Structured, powerful and generous. Lingering a liquorice taste.

Lebanonese Red

Bekaa Valley

463. Domaine Château Musar | 1998

€190

Founded in 1930 by Gaston Hochar in an 18th century castle in Ghazir. The Château is now run by sons Serge and Ronald. DESSERT WINES

Germany

482. Zeltinger Sonnenuhr Riesling Auslese, 37.5cl | 2003 €66

Weingut Selbach Oster Hints of honeysuckle, pears, apricots, and even lime. It's a very complex Riesling. There's bright acidity and zing with a nice long Finish that coats the mouth. This is an excellent wine that has received numerous awards, including 93/100 from Robert Parker.

Canada

483. InnisKillin "Icewine" 50cl | 2002 €150

Known locally as winters gift to wine is one of Canada's most famous wines. Made from Riesling, which are generally handpicked at night. The yield is extremely low, which creates an intensely rich nectar flavour on the palette. An outstanding wine with too many awards and accolades to mention.

Hungary

484. Tokaji Aszú 5 Puttonyes Blue Label 50cl | 1991 €190

The Blue label wines from the Royal Tokaji wine company are selected from the 1st and 2nd growth estates and select growers. 1991 was a great vintage, producing a very sweet, toffee flavour with a rich raisin aftertaste.

485. Tokaji Aszú 5 Puttonyes Nyulászó 50cl | 1991 €265

This celebrated First Growth single vineyard Nyulászó (meaning in Hungarian "to catch rabbits") is one of the most sought after estates in the whole Tokaj wine region. The average age of the vines is 20 years.

Chile

486. Torres Late Harvest Riesling 37.5cl | 2010 €35

Apricot and wild honey nuances, Attractive old-gold colour, with an elegant aroma. Dense and intriguing on the palate with flavours of honey, flowers spices. Voted No.1 in Decanters' "Top 10 sweet wines."

487. Vin Santo di Montepulciano DOCG Romeo 50cl | 1991 €95

Highly concentrated with buckets of ripe fruits, peaches, and nutty apricots. The wine has very complex flavours and the sweetness is well balanced by the acidity, made up by 60% Malvasia, 30% Trebbiano (for its acidity) and 10% Pulcinculo.

France

488. Chateau Rieussec 1er Cru Classe Sauterns | 1982 Bordeaux €425 (Limited)

Not the best vintage but from a severe selection process Chateau Rieussec produced a lovely, lighterstyle wine with medium body and delicate tropical fruit.

489. Amber Hors D'Age Rivesaltes | 1974 €45

Lovely Grenache which is not too heavy and is great with some blue cheese or chocolate fondant.

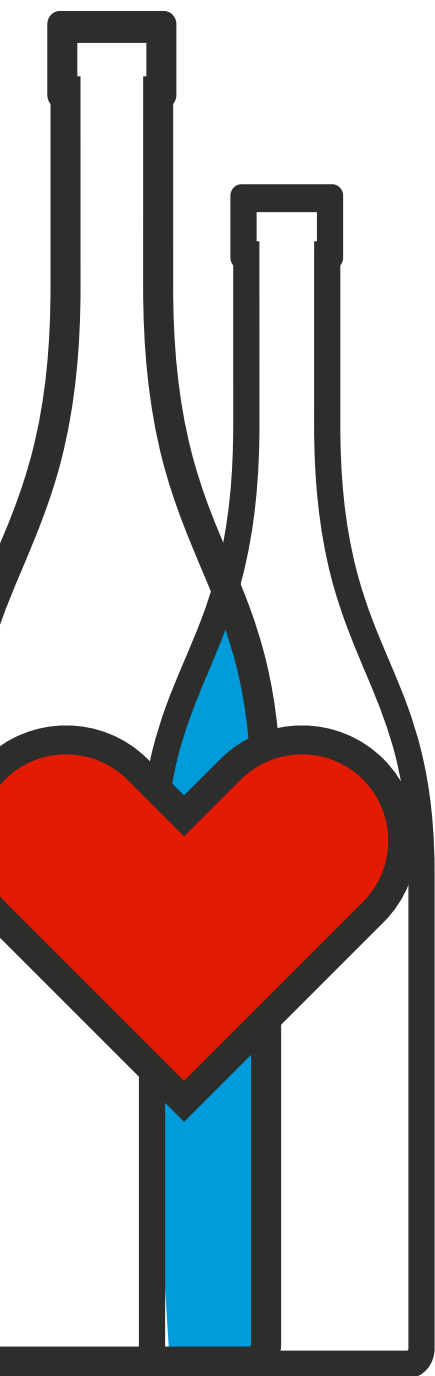
